Saturday saw the B kings travel out to Woodville South oval to tackle Mitcham fc in an elimination final. Finals fever was certainly in the air and the boys were very excited, many of them playing their first final for the club.

Having beaten Mitcham twice during the year in close matches, the lads were quietly confident but also knew that it was going to be a tough contest with both sides very evenly matched.

We won the toss and kicked with the strong breeze to the Northern end in the first quarter. As expected the early tempo was hot, with both sides having a real crack. We had a good amount of play but failed to convert in front of goal and Mitcham hurt us on the counter a few times to score 3 goals into the stiff breeze. Zack Polyak pegged one back on the siren but we trailed by 2 goals at the first change and didn't make use of the strong wind.

The second quarter saw Mitcham do the majority of attacking with the breeze and they outscored us 3.3 to 0.2. Our backline was under extreme pressure at times but they held firm and limited the damage. We were struggling around half forward and found it hard to score but we were still in reach at the main break.

The 3rd quarter become vital with the breeze and we needed to get close to Mitcham to be any chance. We peppered the goals and had all the play but we could only manage 2.2 with Mitcham playing loose players behind the ball and making it hard for us to have any real smooth forward entries. They scored 2 points for the term to make the margin 3 goals at the final change.

We had to take risks, play on at all costs, runs and carry and go direct to be any chance in the last quarter. The boys gave it everything and we had some real good patches of play but couldn't quite get reel in the deficit, finally going down by an even 4 goals.

Our midfield again gave us plenty with Scotty Fischer and Jack Wightman giving it their all and Maxy Read capped off a great season with another stellar performance. Up forward Zac Polyak (3 goals) took some good marks and Milo Mawby was exciting at times and gave us some spark around the packs.

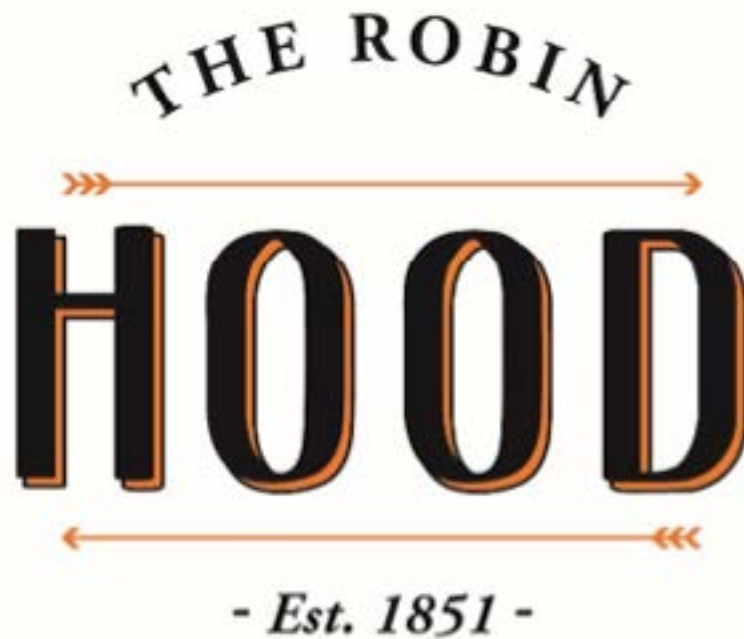
